The Ramappa Temple in Palampet

Ramappa Temple, also known as the Rudreshwara Temple, is a Kakatiya style Hindu temple dedicated to the Hindu god Shiva. An inscription in the temple says it was constructed in the year 1213 CE. Ramappa Temple was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site.



The Thousand Pillar Temple

Rudreswara Swamy Temple is a historical Hindu temple located in the city of Hanamakonda, Telangana, India. It is dedicated to Shiva, Vishnu and Surya. The Thousand Pillar Temple, along with the Warangal Fort. [1] the Kakatiya Kala Thoranam were added to the tentative list of UNESCO World Heritage.



Kakatiya Kala Thoranam

Kakatiya Kala Thoranam (also called Warangal Gate) is a historical arch in the Warangal district, of the Indian state of Telangana. The arch was built around 12th century during the rule of the Kakatiya dynasty.



Bhadrakali Temple

Bhadrakali Temple is one of the oldest temples for Goddess Bhadrakali, situated on a hilltop between the two cities of Hanamakonda and Warangal, Telangana, India. [1] The temple is believed to be built in 625 CE by the King Pulakeshin II of Chalukya dynasty to commemorate his victory over Vengi region of Andhra Desham, as per the writings on the temple wall.
